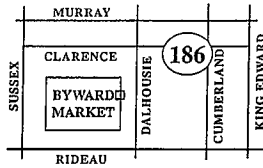

"Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved" (Acts 4:12).

# ARE YOU UNGODLY?

An important question because;  
"Christ died for the ungodly"

Romans 5:6

Please do not be offended at this question. It is not intended to be either insulting or offensive, but is asked because of a real interest in your soul's eternal welfare. The person who has given you this tract did so because he/she earnestly desires that you should spend eternity in heaven rather than in hell. Will you not, then, take a few minutes to carefully and prayerfully read and consider what is written here?

### 1. WHAT IS UNGODLINESS?

"All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23). "And you, who once were alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now He has reconciled in the body of His flesh through death" (Colossians 1:21, 22a). Ungodliness is alienation from and enmity towards God because of sin and the failure to measure up to God's standards.

### 2. WHO ARE UNGODLY?

"There is none righteous, no, not one; there is none who understands; there is none who seeks after God. They have all gone out of the way; they have together become unprofitable; there is none who does good, no not one" (Romans 3:10-12).

This passage along with Romans 3:23, previously quoted, declare that "all have sinned", "there is none righteous", "none does good", "none who seeks after God". The Scriptures

solemnly declare that all men are sinners and thus are ungodly. That little word "all" leaves no exceptions. You may be morally upright and without reproach, yet this declaration of Scripture includes you.

### 3. WHAT HAS GOD DONE FOR THE UNGODLY?

"For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly ... God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us" (Romans 5:6,8). God, in His love, gave His Son to die in the sinner's place that the ungodly sinner might be saved and made fit for God's presence.

### 4. WHAT HAS THIS TO DO WITH YOU?

Like everyone else you are a sinner by birth and by deed and therefore are estranged from God. It is important that you recognize this because your salvation depends upon it. "But the Scripture has confined all under sin, that the promise by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe" (Galatians 3:22). If you consider yourself to be a righteous person, then you cannot be saved, for Christ came not "to call the righteous, but sinners, to repentance" (Matthew 9:13). Again the Lord Jesus said, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick" (Matthew 9:12). Christ came to seek and to save the lost
